Front and Rear Canopy Support Brackets




Figure 1: Front Support Canopy Brackets

In Figure 1 and Figure 2 below are the canopy support brackets for the Ford T6/T7 Ranger.

Mounting the Support Brackets to the Load Bin

Removing the Standard Hooks Remove the standard hooks using a T40 spline socket and ratchet.




Figure 3: Standard Hook Points

Bolting the Front and Rear Mounting Brackets to the Load Bin.




Figure 5: Top View of Load Bin

Figures 5 to Figure 10 shows where and how the support brackets are fixed to the load bin. The top of the brackets must be flush with the load bin.




Figure 6: Side View of Load Bin






Figure 7: Rear Canopy Support Bracket Position




Figure 8: Front Canopy Support Bracket Position




Figure 10: Front Bracket Mounting Assembly

Centre Mounting Brackets

In Figure 14 below is the assembly of the centre mounting bracket which consists of the canopy mounting bracket and the load bin mounting bracket.




Figure 12: Load Bin Mounting Bracket




Figure 13: Centre Bracket Mounting Assembly




Figure 14: Centre Mounting Bracket Assembly



Mounting the Centre Mounting Bracket




Figure 15: Section View of Clamping Method

In Figure 15 below shows how the centre mounting bracket clamps onto the load bin.

## Canopy Installation

Before placing the canopy onto the load bin, check that the D-Rubber is intact on the canopy. If this is not done, the canopy and/or load bin could be damaged or can cause leaks into the canopy.

To position the canopy, ensure that it is flush with the load bin.




Figure 16: Canopy and Load Bin Alignment



Canopy Fitment to Load bin

Open all the doors of the canopy and place onto the load bin.

Step 1 - Bolting the Universal Bracket to the Support Bracket.




Figure 17: Universal-Front Bracket Mounting Assembly




Figure 18: Universal-Rear Bracket Mounting Assembly

In Figure 17 and Figure 18 below shows how the universal bracket is mounted to the front and rear support brackets.

Bolting the Universal Bracket to the Canopy




Figure 19: Rear Universal to Canopy Mounting assembly

When the Universal bracket is bolted to the mounting brackets, it should then be mounted to the canopy. In Figure 19 and Figure 20 shows the fastener assembly.




Figure 21: Tightening Universal bracket to Canopy

The canopy must rest solely on the mounting brackets and no load is allowed on the load bin. Once this is completed, the canopy has been installed successfully.
